This position is responsible to the Manager of Community and Strategic Planning for the complete management, direction and operation of the Geographic Information, Surveys and Mapping Group. This includes responsibility for the development of strategies for corporate implementation of GIS processes and for the creation and implementation of policies, programs and priorities for data elements of the GIS. The Co-ordinator also oversees the development and maintenance of key GIS data sets including parcel fabric, topography, addresses, streets, control surveys and orthophotography.

The successful candidate will possess:

- A University degree in a related discipline (e.g. Survey Engineering or Geodetic Science, specializing in geodetic control and photogrammetric mapping) from a recognized University with Canadian accreditation with additional education initiatives to update and expand competencies.
- **An Ontario Land Surveyor's Licence.**
- A minimum of five (5) years of senior level experience in the management of a large, unionized, and highly diversified public or private sector organization, including three (3) years managing a similar function (e.g. control surveys, large scale photogrammetric mapping).

NOTE: Less qualified candidates who can be expected to meet the required qualification within a reasonable period of time may be considered for the position as a developmental opportunity.
