Honourable Danny Williams
Premier of Newfoundland and Labrador

Danny Williams has served as Premier of Newfoundland and Labrador since November 2003. Under his leadership, the province has experienced: unprecedented economic growth and activity; a substantial reduction in the provincial debt; lower taxation rates; significantly increased benefits for the citizens of the province in the development of natural resources; and a progressive social agenda including nationally acclaimed strategies on Poverty Reduction and Student Debt Reform.

Lieutenant Governor of Newfoundland and Labrador

John Carnell Crosbie became the 12th Lieutenant Governor of Newfoundland and Labrador in February 2008 following a distinguished career in public life and the law.

Mr. Crosbie successively held the portfolios of Federal Minister of Finance, President of the Treasury Board, and Minister of Economic Development; Minister of Fisheries and Minister of Intergovernmental Affairs; Minister of Justice; Attorney General; Minister of Mines and Energy and Minister for Intergovernmental Affairs; Minister of Transport; Minister for International Trade; and Minister of Fisheries and Oceans and Minister for the Atlantic Canada Opportunities Agency (ACOA).

As Minister for International Trade, Mr. Crosbie was responsible for the Canada-U.S. Free Trade Agreement and its successor the US, Mexico, Canada or NAFTA Agreement.
